Granted emergency funding to CFD families in crisis. Provided funding to the children of Firefighter Juan Buscio who was killed in the line of duty in 2018. Supported the essential work of the Gold Badge Society for families of CFD members lost in the line of duty. Created grant funding for the CFD Pipes and Drums. Participated in neighborhood events where fire safety literature was distributed along with smoke detectors.
